

### **Vendor Fun Facts**

Total number of vendors in October 2021: 3,816. Decreased 1.4% from October 2020.

Total transactions for October 2021: 1,717,623. Increased 25% from October 2020.

Total reimbursements for October 2021: \$67,575,279. Increased 19% from October 2020.

On average, 545,000 families redeemed benefits every month.

Average family expenditures over last FFY: \$109/month. Increased 23% to \$122 from May 2021 to June 2021 (CVB expansion).












# California WIC Vendors: Number of Transactions (October 2020 – October 2021)










## California WIC: Average Dollars Redeemed per Family (November 2020 – September 2021)

### **Physical Card Presence**

- On September 22, 2021, CDPH/WIC published <u>Vendor Alert 2021-05</u>, which reminded vendors that the physical WIC Card must be present at the time of purchase for all WIC Card transactions and that the card must be swiped by the store's Point of Sale card reader to process the WIC Card transaction.
- If the store's Point of Sale system is unable to read the card's magnetic stripe, the cashier may
  manually enter the WIC Card number, but the card still must be physically present.
- The WIC App may not be used in place of a physical card, and under no circumstances should a cashier enter a PIN on behalf of a shopper.

## Routine Monitoring Visits (RMVs)

- All WIC state agencies are required to conduct RMVs at WIC authorized stores.
- Thank you to those vendors who participated in the Virtual RMV process.
- CDPH/WIC will now be conducting on-site RMVs statewide. The Vendor Management Team will start the process with a Courtesy Call.
- Items for review during an RMV include a valid Health Permit, Infant Formula Invoices, and Minimum Stocking Requirements.
- During RMVs, WIC Staff may observe WIC Card transactions to ensure they are being completed properly, along with conduct additional reviews, such as verifying that WIC authorized products for sale are not expired.

### **Shelf Price Submission**

- <u>Vendor Alert 2021-07</u> is a 30-Day Notice for the Mandatory Vendor Shelf Price Submission Period. The Vendor Alert was published and emailed to vendors on October 29, 2021.
- Vendors must submit shelf prices for the 11 Market Basket Items for the period November 29, 2021, through December 12, 2021.
- Prices must be submitted into VWIX no later than 11:59 P.M. on December 28, 2021.





### New Temporary WIC Fruits and Vegetables Benefit increase through December 2021!

#### Dear Friends:

Exciting news! From October to December 2021, California WIC families will see a new temporary increase in their monthly WIC Cash-Value Fruits and Vegetables Benefit to:

\$24 for children age one to five \$43 for pregnant and postpartum individuals \$47 for breastfeeding individuals

The new temporary increase to the WIC Fruits and Vegetables Benefit was approved by Congress and signed into law in September. Under normal circumstances, the monthly WIC Fruits and Vegetables Benefit is \$9 for children and \$11 for pregnant, postpartum, and breastfeeding individuals

Enjoy the new WIC fruits and veggies benefit increase through December!

Fruits and vegetables are a rich source of a variety of nutrients critical to improving maternal and child health outcomes. Eating fruits and vegetables as part of an overall healthy diet reduces the risk of chronic disease, such as diabetes and cardiovascular disease, and strengthens the immune system. The new increase to the WIC Fruits and Vegetables Benefit will significantly support WIC families in reaching their nutrition goals and advancing their health and well-being.

The California Department of Public Health/Women, Infants, and Children Division (CDPH/WIC) is sharing a communications toolkit designed to help get the word out about the new WIC Fruits and Vegetable Benefit increase. The toolkit includes social media posts, mobile-friendly flyers, sample talking points, and sample text messaging.
