Summary of Involuntary Termination

The Horizon House I Facility is hereby involuntary terminated from Medi-Cal participation, effective May 20, 2022 and this serves as notice to the public.

Notice is hereby given that on May 20, 2022, Horizon House I, located on 2170 Ermine Ave, Ventura, 93003-6811, California as a Intermediate Care Facility for the Developmentally Disabled-Nursing (ICF-DD-N) has been involuntarily terminated from Medi-Cal participation.

The Department of Public Health has determined that Horizon House I has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medi-Cal participation requirements:

- 42 CFR 483.410 (W102) Governing Body and Management
- 42 CFR 483.430 (W158) Facility Staffing
- 42 CFR 483.440 (W195) Active Treatment Services
- 42 CFR 483.460 (W318) Health Care Services

The Medi-Cal program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after May 20, 2022. For residents admitted prior to May 20, 2022 payment may continue for up to 30 days of services on or after May 20, 2022, the date of termination.

This action is mandated by Sections 1819(h)(2)(C) of the Social Security Act and Federal regulations at 42 CFR §488.412 and 488.456.
