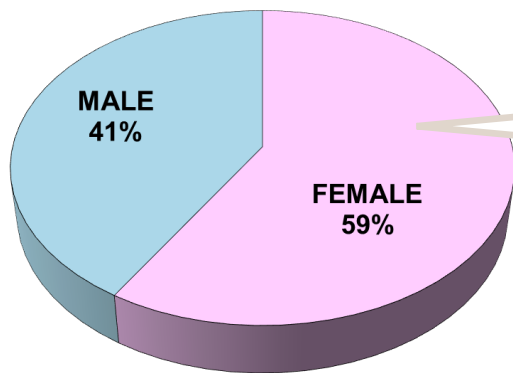

### Caregivers of Persons Living with Alzheimer’s Disease, Dementia, or Other Cognitive Impairment Disorder

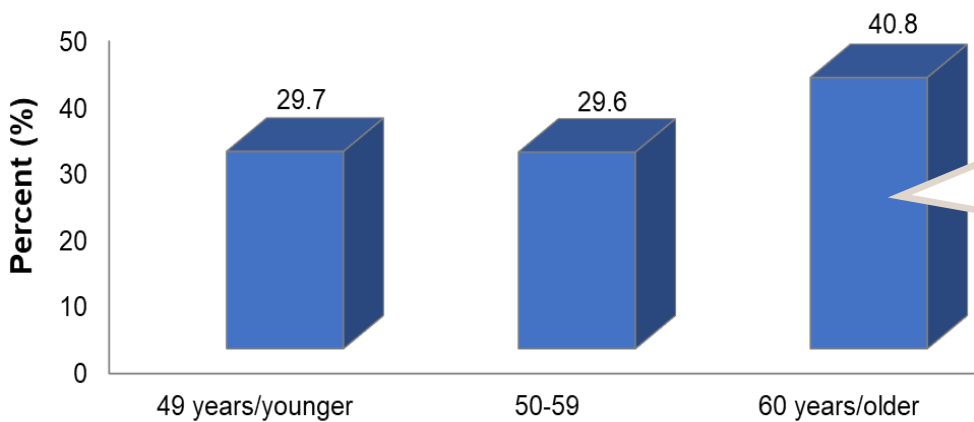

#### Caregivers’ Profile



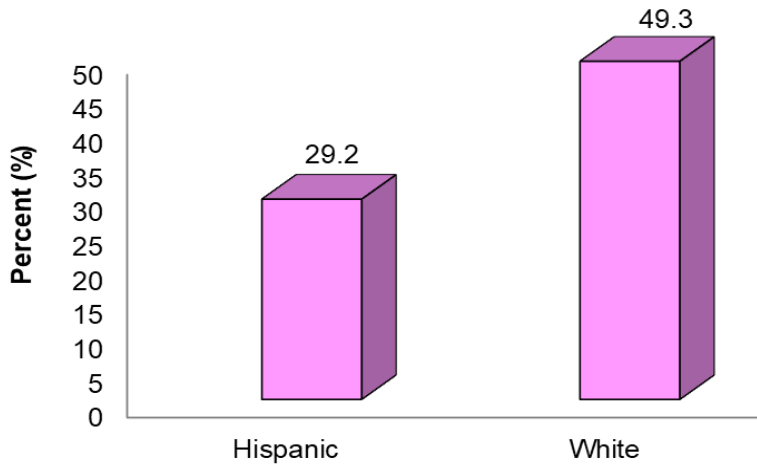
**59%** of caregivers are women

# Deeper Dive: Caregivers' Profile

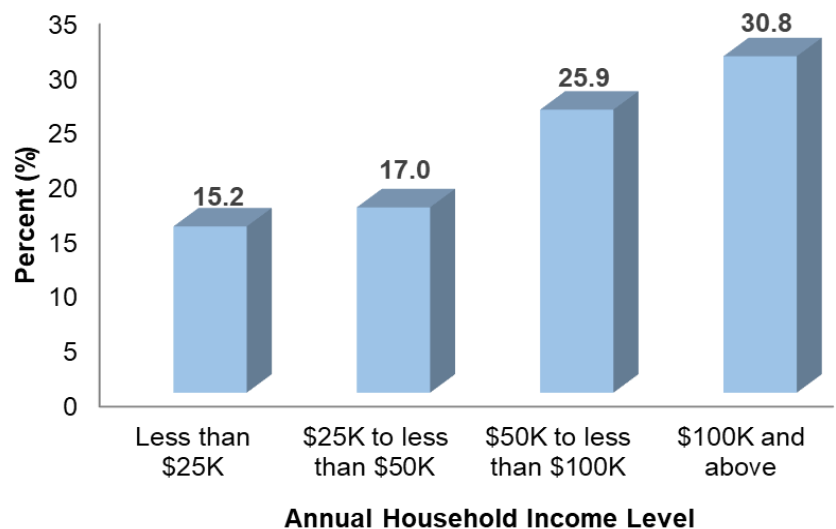

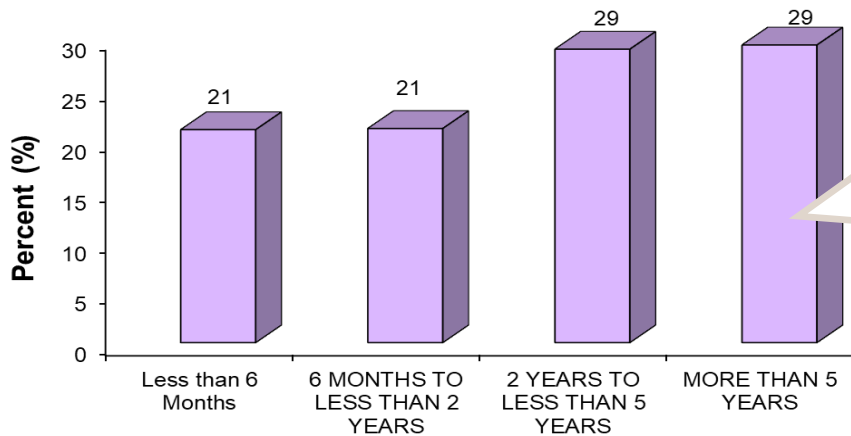

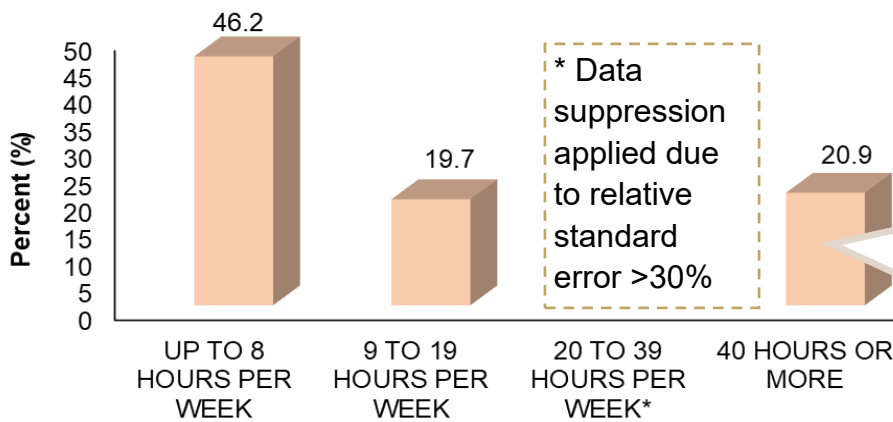

**29%** of caregivers provided care for more than 5 years

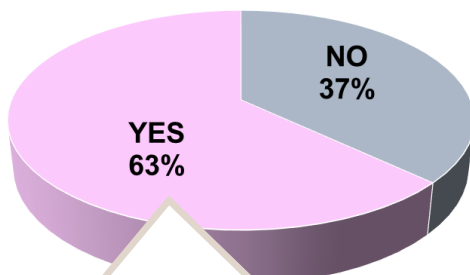


Hours of Care Provided

**~21%** of caregivers provided 40 hours or more care to recipients

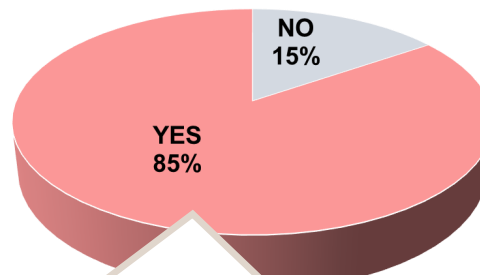
## Tasks Provided To Care Recipients
