## Preventive Medicine Residents' Roles in the Response to SARS-CoV-2, January 1 to June 30, 2020

Five Preventive Medicine Residents were in the midst of their training program when SARS-CoV-2 arrived in California. Nonetheless, in the very early days of the pandemic, between January 1 through June 30, 2020, all residents participated in emergency response activities, either clinical and/orpublic health, in Los Angeles, Marin, San Francisco, Yolo and Sacramento County local health departments.

Residents established new testing sites; participated in or led contact tracing teams; and, provided consultation to congregate facilities to reduce infectionrates. Some accepted leadership positions as a Deputy Health Officer or Incident Commander and Operations Chief. The residents' work in local health departments during the pandemic proved to be a unique opportunity for training in emergency response and made an essential contribution to local health departments in need of highly qualified staff.
