15620 (Kaitlyn's Law) - A child who is 6 years of age or younger may not leave that child inside a vehicle without being subject to the supervision of a person who is 12 years of age or older, under either of the following circumstances: (1) where there are conditions that present a significant risk to the child's health or safety, (2) when the vehicle's engine is running or the vehicle's keys are in the ignition, or both. Violations to 15620 are recorded under 15620 A. http://www.dmv.ca.gov/pubs/vctop/d06_7/vc15620.htm

27360 - A child cannot be transported without properly securing the child in a rear seat in a child passenger restraint system unless the child is one of the following: six years of age or older, or 60 pounds or more. If the parent/legal guardian is in the vehicle then the violation is recorded under 27360 A. If the parent/legal guardian is absent, then the driver of the vehicle will receive the violation and it is recorded under 27360 B. <http://www.dmv.ca.gov/pubs/vctop/d12/vc27360.htm>

27360.5 - No parent/legal guardian or when absent in the vehicle the driver, may permit a child who is six years of age or older, but less than 16 years of age, or who is less than six years of age and weighs 60 pounds or more without properly securing the child in an appropriate child passenger restraint system or safety belt. http://www.dmv.ca.gov/pubs/vctop/d12/vc27360_5.htm

27315 D – A person may not operate a motor vehicle on a highway unless that person and all passengers 16 years of age or over are properly restrained by a safety belt. This code also applies to all passengers over six years old or 60 pounds in the front seat of taxi cabs, limos or in an emergency vehicle. Violations excluding passengers in a sleeping berth are recorded under 27315 E. <http://www.dmv.ca.gov/pubs/vctop/d12/vc27315.htm>

27315 F - Every owner of a vehicle, including every owner or operator of a taxicab or a limousine for hire, shall maintain safety belts in good working order for the use of occupants of the vehicle.
