

The Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis Assistance Program (PrEP-AP) works to increase PrEP accessibility and uptake for eligible Californians, and ensures that underserved, at risk Californians have access to medical care and services to prevent new HIV infections. PrEP-AP provides assistance to both uninsured and insured individuals at risk for HIV.



CLINICAL PROVIDERS

are providers who work with PrEP-AP to offer PrEP-related medical care to clients who are uninsured, are minors, or who have confidentiality concerns*. PrEP-AP clinical providers work at PrEP-AP Clinical Provider Sites, and provide the following services to enrolled PrEP-AP clients:

Confirm PrEP-AP Enrollment



Rapid **Anti-Retroviral** Therapy (ART)



PrEP Follow-up



Complete **PrEP-AP Provider Referral Form**
