1. Evaluation of courses for science credit only: Environmental Engineering, Applied Chemistry and Microbiology – *The subcommittee members unanimously agreed these courses would not satisfy the requirements for science credit.*
2. Evaluation of Chem 306 – *After reviewing the course description and the articulation agreement from CSU San Bernardino, Dr. Lal Mian agreed to speak with the department and perhaps get a letter stating the Chem 306 course is equivalent to one of the Organic Chemistry courses at the university.*
3. Evaluation of coursework for Option III – *After reviewing the syllabus for 5 courses submitted for review under Option III, the subcommittee members agreed all would satisfy the Option III requirement.*
4. Evaluation of coursework for Option V – Benadictine University – An online search concluded that Benadictine University is accredited by the North Central Association and can satisfy the Option V curriculum. *The members suggested to required 200 hours of internship to the candidate letter once the degree is granted.*
5. Appeal of CPS HR Consulting decision to require Basic Biology Lecture and Laboratory – *This item will be discussed at the next subcommittee meeting.*
