

Environmental Health Training in Emergency Response February 14 and 16, 2012, San Leandro

This course is based on material created by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention National Center for Environmental Health and hosted by *Alameda County Environmental Health, Contra Costa County Environmental Health* and the *California Department of Public Health*. The course will be held from 8am-5pm on Tuesday, 2/14/12 and Thursday, 2/16/12.

The purpose of this 2-day course is to increase the level of emergency preparedness and response of public and environmental health practitioners by providing the necessary knowledge and skills to address the environmental health impacts of disasters. Topics covered will include the role of the environmental health specialist related to food and drinking water supplies, responder health and safety, shelter sanitation, debris/solid/hazardous waste handling, vector control, wastewater.


This 2-day course will take place 8:00am - 5pm on both days (non-consecutive days). The course is offered free of tuition fees and provides 16 hours of Continuing Education credit for CA Registered Environmental Health Specialists available through the California Environmental Health Association (CEHA).

San Leandro Public Library, 300 Estudillo Ave. San Leandro, CA 94577


This venue is about 1/2 mile from the San Leandro BART station. Use of public transportation and car pooling is recommended, as free, unrestricted parking in the area is limited.
