

## **Focus Area 1: Access to Health Care**

### **Objective 1-12: Establish a single toll-free telephone number for access to poison control centers on a 24-hour basis throughout the United States.**

The California Poison Control System, managed by the University of California San Francisco (UCSF), School of Pharmacy, Department of Clinical Pharmacy, consists of four answering sites: UC Davis Medical Center (Sacramento Division), San Francisco General Hospital (San Francisco Division), Children's Hospital Central California (Fresno/Madera Division), UC San Diego Medical Center (San Diego Division). The central administrative office is located at UCSF's Laurel Heights campus in San Francisco. CPCS is a certified member of the American Association of Poison Control Centers.
