


Focus Area 14: Immunization and Infectious Diseases

Objective 14-7. Reduce meningococcal disease. Target = 1.0 per 100,000 population [State Data Source: National Notifiable Disease Surveillance System (NNDSS), CDC, EPO; CDPH Immunization Branch]

Meningococcal disease rates declined significantly from 1.0 per 100,000 population in 2000 to 0.5 per 100,000 in 2007 (**Figure 14-7**). This HP2010 objective was being achieved for all Californians as of 2000.
