

## **Focus Area 23: Public Health Infrastructure**

**Objective 23-2. (Developmental) Increase the proportion of State and local health agencies that have made information available for internal or external public use in the past year based on health indicators related to Healthy People 2010 (HP2010) objectives. Target = To Be Determined [State Data Source: California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Health Information and Strategic Planning (HISP) Division]**

The CDPH Center for Health Statistics (CHS), Office of Health Information and Research (OHIR) monitors approximately 24.5 percent (n=221) of the 901 HP2010 objectives and subobjectives in 28 Focus Areas using data available from DATA2010, California Vital Statistics (birth and death data), the California Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) Patient Discharge Data files, and the California Health Interview Survey (CHIS). A “Healthy California 2010 Progress Report” is available on the Web at <http://www.cdph.ca.gov/data/indicators/goals/Pages/HC2010Progress.aspx>, and is updated periodically as new data become available.

The CHS/OHIR also publishes the “County Health Status Profiles” report annually in conjunction with Public Health Week activities (see <http://www.cdph.ca.gov/programs/OHIR/Pages/CHSP.aspx>). These reports provide county-level data on approximately 20 HP2010 mortality, morbidity, and natality objectives.
