


Focus Area 26: Substance Abuse

Objective 26-10a. Increase the proportion of adolescents aged 12 to 17 years not using alcohol or any illicit drugs during the past 30 days. Target = 91.0 percent [State Data Source: National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH), SAMHSA]

According to data collected by the NSDUH, the average annual proportion of California adolescents aged 12-17 years who had not used any illicit drugs during the past 30 days increased from 88.6 percent for 2002-2003 to 89.4 percent for 2004-2005 (**Figure 26-10a**). For alcohol, the proportion of adolescents not using decreased from 84.7 percent for 2002-2003 to 83.8 percent for 2004-2005.
