# CDPH 2013 Accreditation Goals

- **Complete PHAB Steps One through Three**
  1. Pre-application - (SOI 3/13) ✓
  2. Application – 9/13 ←
  3. Documentation Selection and Submission - 12/13
- **Prepare for PHAB site visit in 2014**

# CDPH Accreditation Activities

- **Accreditation Readiness Team (ART)** formed as a subcommittee of the CDPH Policy Committee
- **Domain Teams & Team Champions** for each of the 12 PHAB Domains
- **Domain Teams**
  - Multi-disciplinary membership: Subject Matter Experts from across CDPH
  - Identifying documentation for PHAB Step 3
  - Facilitating site visits








## Support to LHDs
