SUBJECT: FEE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016

Effective July 1, 2016, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Food and Drug Branch (FDB) licensing fees will increase by 30 percent pursuant to the California Health and Safety (H&S) Code Sections 111630 and 111656.1 authorizing CDPH to establish and adjust licensing fees to cover the estimated program costs.

Please note that existing fees were established in 2004 for support of program operations and have not been adjusted since. The rate increase for the new fees was determined by CDPH working closely with the California Department of Finance (DOF), and will allow the fund to remain solvent and cover the costs of program operations for the next fiscal year. Program will continue to work closely with DOF to re-evaluate in future years.
