CALIFORNIA

If your child has health coverage through **Medi-Cal** or a **Covered California** health plan, he or she also has dental coverage and can go to the dentist for regular checkups and care.



Services Covered for Children (Covered California and Medi-Cal)

- Exams
- X-rays
- Cleanings
- Fillings
- Fluoride treatments
- Sealants
- Tooth extractions
- Root canals
- Emergency services
- Relief of pain and infection
- Medically necessary orthodontics

Covered California

When you signed your child up for a Covered California health plan, he or she was automatically enrolled in dental coverage. Contact your health plan to find a dentist or if you have questions about your dental care. For more information, visit www.coveredca.com or call (800) 300-1506.

Medi-Cal

The Medi-Cal Benefits Identification Card you received in the mail is also your child's dental coverage card. To find a dentist that accepts Medi-Cal, call (800) 322-6384, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., or look online at www.denti-cal.ca.gov. Click on "Find a Medi-Cal Dentist."

Parents, Single Adults, and Pregnant Women
