

How to use OSHPD's interactive mapping program "Healthcare Atlas"

3. Select:
 - a. Locate Tab



- b. Feature type (example, Medical Service Study Area)



c. Select county and specific MSSA of interest.

Locate

The Locate tool will search, locate and zoom to a healthcare facility or area of interest on the map. Make menu selections below.

Select a feature type to locate:


Select a county:
 (narrows the choices)

Select a MSSA:

Your chosen feature will display on the simple map to the right. To view your feature in full map detail, click the "View on Map Tab" link below the map.



Select Locate on Map



Select "Perform Deep Drill-down" for additional details about the feature. (a)

Use zoom on the map to change the view. View up close, (large scale) use the top to zoom (b), to see more of the surroundings, less detail (small scale) use the bottom to zoom (c).
