

Elective PCI Advisory Oversight Committee (AOC) Requirements

Duties of the AOC committee:

1. Submit at least two reports to the department during the pilot period.
2. Conduct a final report at the end of the pilot, including recommendations to continue or terminate the program.
3. Attend all meetings via telephone.

You will be notified well in advance of the meeting dates and times.

Tentative Meeting Dates:

1. July 29, 2010. Initial introductions, review of study protocols with UCD, and pilot project setup.
2. August 19, 2010.
3. Meetings then quarterly.
