



## **Web StoreFront - No Allocations for FFY 2016**

The Nutrition Education and Obesity Prevention Branch (NEOPB) is removing barriers to accessing Web StoreFront (WSF) materials by eliminating agency allocations. This effort streamlines the ordering process, eliminating the cumbersome agency-specific allocation and tracking requirements. State Implementing Agencies (SIAs) and Local Implementing Agencies (LIAs) can now order materials without allocation and tracking constraints.

NEOPB has set aside WSF materials for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2016 based on material usage. Once these materials have been distributed, there will be no additional materials made available until the next FFY or until reprinting occurs, budget permitting. We ask that funded SIAs/LIAs order only the materials needed for planned interventions for FFY 2016 in an effort to be considerate of other SIAs/LIAs that may also need materials.

NOTE: SIAs/LIAs must be able to receive and store all materials ordered. Additional considerations may be needed for large pallets such as a forklift and/or other equipment needed to move heavy and large orders.

The list will be updated quarterly as needed.
