We are pleased to announce that the Champion Alliance Program (CAP) has been making great progress in the past several months. Our CAP partners have been working tirelessly to recruit a minimum of 40 new Champions for Change from throughout the state, and they have exceeded this target! This is an added resource for your convenience.

We currently have 56 trained and excited new Champions that are willing, ready and able to help their local health departments with community events and educational presentations utilizing the Champions for Change Toolkits such as, *Eat the MyPlate Way*, *Choosing Healthy Beverages*, and *Get Physical*.

As a reminder, this is a pilot program and consequently we will have Champions available only in select counties and service areas. To date, we have:

 - **Sacramento County**
