Compliance Monitoring Report
First Quarter
January - March 2012

Compliance for 2011

There have been 175 presumptive SIDS cases reported to the California SIDS Program for 2011 through April 18, 2012. Compliance for submission of Coroner Notification Cards (CNCs) is 96% and for Public Health Services Report (PHSR) forms compliance is 96%. The County of Fresno is the most delinquent with submission of CNCs.

Compliance for 2012

There have been 36 presumptive SIDS cases reported to the California SIDS Program for 2012 through April 18, 2012. Compliance for submission of Coroner Notification Cards (CNCs) is 94% and for Public Health Services Report (PHSR) forms compliance is 36%. Compared to the 1st quarterly report for last year (2011) there were 45 presumptive SIDS cases reported. Compliance for submission of CNCs compared to last year has increased by 5% and compliance for submission of PHSR forms has decreased by 28%.

Quarterly compliance letters were mailed March 29, 2012 for those counties delinquent with submission of the State Coroner Notification Cards and Public Health Services Report forms for 2012. Thirteen (13) compliance letters were mailed to six (6) County Coroner Offices. Nineteen (19) compliance letters were sent to four (4) SIDS County Coordinators. See listing below for counties non-compliant with the SIDS mandate as of March 29, 2012.
