


Ways to Remember My Brother or Sister Who Died

- ❖ Make a memory book
- ❖ Draw pictures
- ❖ Write a poem or a story
- ❖ Ask my family for something that belonged to my brother or sister to keep for myself
- ❖ Make a photo album that has pictures of my brother or sister in it
- ❖ Make up a song
- ❖ Go to the cemetery and visit my baby brother or sister
- ❖ Add my brother or sister's name to birthday cards, Mother's Day cards, Father's Day cards, or any other holiday card when it is signed
- ❖ Keep a picture of my baby brother or sister in my room
- ❖ Tell a special friend about my baby brother or sister
- ❖ Help raise money for SIDS
- ❖ Talk into a tape recorder and share things I remember about my baby brother or sister
- ❖ Ask other people to talk into the tape recorder to share what they remember
- ❖ Plant a tree
- ❖ Write a letter to my brother or sister
- ❖ Say prayers for my baby brother or sister
- ❖ Do something special on the day my brother or sister was born
- ❖ Do something special on the day my brother or sister died
- ❖ Write a letter to my family about our baby who died
- ❖ Give a gift to a hospital for children in honor of my brother or sister
