This table depicts the process identified to high need areas with gaps in services. First, the county has to have an AFLP site. Second, the county has to have a Cal-SAFE child care only site without additional support services. There are sites also in jeopardy of losing Cal-SAFE support services, leaving them with child care only in fiscal year 2010 -2011. This would allow them to participate, and as such they are noted by an asterisk. Finally, potential sites were identified, via health status indicators, as described in the legend above. Included as possible sites are Riverside and San Bernardino Counties, if new contractors can be identified and AFLP contracts retored in fiscal year 2010 - 2011.
