

LEO Release Notes: July 2012

This document is intended to inform you of changes to the LEO system associated with the current LEO release. It includes a brief summary of the recent system changes, and a list of known issues.

Brief Summary of Changes

This LEO release includes a number of important new features, including:

- Data entry functionality for the Healthcare HIV Test Form (expanded testing)
- HCPI records
- are now viewable
- New DEBI intervention options

Other minor changes include:

- Bugs causing sporadic crashes when running reports have been fixed. (Affected HIV Test Results by Risk Category and C&T Indicators Report).
- Additional instances of E&P and PCRS labels were changed to HE/RR and PS, respectively.
- Bug causing crashes when there is a person pending approval to be added to a new agency has been fixed.
- Person search with no search terms now finds all persons in the LEO system.

Data Entry for Healthcare HIV Test Form

Data entry screens are now available for expanded testing activities (screening interventions in LEO). These screens should be used to enter records for client visits documented on the Healthcare HIV Test Form (HTF) for which the test result was something other than negative (i.e., usually preliminary or confirmed positive records). Please see the end of these release notes for known issues affecting data entry for the HTF.

Data entry training for the HTF will be offered within the next two weeks. Agencies involved in providing screening interventions will receive an e-mail soon providing details about signing up for the training.

HCPI Records Now Viewable

A previous patch resulted in a bug that caused a system error when attempting to view HCPI-Media and HCPI-Education intervention records. That bug has been fixed, and existing HCPI records are now accessible in the system.

New DEBI Choices

In intervention set-up, if a DEBI intervention is being performed, the specific DEBI must be identified via a pull-down menu. The following DEBIs have been added to the options available:

- CLEAR
- ¡Cuidate!
- Connect
- FIO: The Future is Ours
- Nia
- Personalized Cognitive Counseling (PCC)
- Project AIM
- Project START
- SHIELD
- SHILE
- Sister to Sister
- WILLOW

Known Issues

- From the encounter summary screen, the link to the “Referrals” section is not live until a test form has been entered. You can enter data into the referrals section either by clicking ‘save and next’ from the previous screen, or by entering data into the test form first.
- In the Residence State/Territory field, there is no option to enter for a client who does not reside in a US state or territory, so services for clients who live outside the US cannot be recorded until this option is added in a subsequent patch.
- Some date fields are inappropriately restricted to within the fiscal year of the intervention, such as dates for partner services. So services which happen outside the intervention fiscal year cannot be recorded until the bug is corrected in an upcoming patch.
