

LEO Release Notes: March 2013

This document is intended to inform you of changes to the LEO system associated with the current LEO release. It includes a brief summary of the recent system changes, and a list of known issues.

Summary of Changes

This LEO release includes several small bug fixes, including:

- Validation fixes
- Completed records must be marked 'incomplete' to be edited
- Records in closed interventions are read-only
- Known crashing errors have been corrected

Validation Fixes

Several validations were inadvertently left off, including the requirement to have one or more lab slips if the client tested. These validations have been added and apply to new records that are entered. In a subsequent patch a script will be run to apply all system validations to existing FY12-13 data as part of a data clean-up effort.

Complete Records and Closed Interventions

System checks have been added to ensure that records in closed interventions cannot be edited. This protects data integrity and improves report consistency by preventing accidental editing of older data. If data from a closed intervention needs to be corrected, providers should contact OA for assistance.

Records that are marked complete must be marked incomplete in order to edit them. In open interventions, this can be done by any staff who have permission to enter data into LEO. This restriction is intended to prevent accidental data editing on records that are complete.
