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# Laying a Foundation for Getting to Zero: California's Integrated Surveillance, Prevention, and Care Plan

- Joint effort between state, local, and community partners
- Will set forth California's commitment to collaboration, efficiency, and innovation in order to meet or exceed National HIV/AIDS Strategy prevention, care, and treatment goals
- Provide a vision and foundation for eventually getting to zero new HIV infections in California
- Must cover calendar years 2017 – 2021
- Due to our federal funders on September 30, 2016

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- Serve as jurisdictional HIV/AIDS Strategy
- Definition of jurisdiction
  - State statute
  - CDC
  - HRSA
- Vision for California
- Also serve as
  - California Project Area Prevention Plan for CDC
  - SCSN, Ryan White Part B Care Plan for California
  - Ryan White Part A Care Plan for Sacramento, Riverside/San Bernardino, Santa Clara Counties

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- Required to align with NHAS goals
- Include measurable objectives to achieve over 5 years
  - At least 2 per NHAS goal
- Strategies to meet these objectives
  - At least 3 per NHAS goal
- Activities/interventions used for each strategy
- Resources committed toward implementation

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- Vision and foundation for Getting to Zero
- Full Affordable Care Act Implementation
- Not just Office of AIDS funded activities
- Collaboration and coordination with other public and private payers
