SUBJECT: ADAP 120-day Medi-Cal eligibility determination grace period increased to 150 days.

As a result of ongoing communication with the California Department of Social Services, Medi-Cal Regional Offices (responsible for making disability/eligibility determinations for Medi-Cal applicants), the Office of AIDS (OA) has been informed that the current average timeframe from date of application to a disability determination has increased to 150 days.

Given this updated Medi-Cal application timeline, the current ADAP 120-day grace period will be increased to 150 days. This change will take effect immediately.
