National HIV/AIDS Strategy Goal 4:

Achieve a more coordinated response to the HIV epidemic



Challenges to Coordination

- Care/services provided by multiple entities
 - New medical providers
- Diverse funding streams & resulting silos
- Affordable Care Act – Opportunities & Challenges
 - Covered California
 - Medi-Cal expansion



OA Activities to Improve Coordination

- Increasing collaboration with STD
 - Partner services
 - Linkage and re-engagement in care
 - Comprehensive HIV/STD testing
- Data sharing to improve understanding of unmet needs
 - Matching with Medi-Cal and Covered California
 - Linking surveillance, care, treatment and prevention data
- Focus on providing support services for patients receiving care outside of Ryan White



Future Work to Support Collaboration

- Broaden OA scope to state-wide perspective
 - Beyond California Project Area or Ryan White providers
 - Better communication w/ LA and SF
- Increase engagement with private providers and health plans
 - Expanded testing
 - Retention in care
 - Support services
