DESCRIPTION

These webinars address various HIV-specific topics including:

Women's Health and HIV

This webinar focuses on two critical yet often overlooked facets of total health and wellness for women: mental health and spirituality. HIV cannot be treated in a silo and requires addressing all aspects of a person's well being to maximize their quality of life. This webinar raises awareness and addresses the mental, physical and emotional needs of women of color affected by HIV/AIDS. This webinar will discuss how to integrate these factors into the care and treatment of women living with HIV.

Building Wealth for Community Based Organizations (CBOs) Part 1: Introduction to Fundraising Planning

This webinar introduces participants to the essential components of a fundraising plan. CBO staff will have an opportunity to reaffirm what works and rethink what doesn't, consider goal setting, and hear about strategies for how to stay focused on the big picture. Participants will receive concrete tools and guidance on developing case statements, identifying agency assets and resources, and taking steps to diversify funding sources.

Building Wealth for CBOs Part 2: Steps to Engaging Foundations

This webinar discusses strategies for finding, evaluating, and approaching foundations and corporate partners as well as how to outline strategies for making initial contact and building long-term relationships. Participants will be guided through proven steps and activities to engage new funding partners.

Stronger Together: Building Coalitions that Thrive

This webinar outlines the successes and challenges of coalition-building, recommends strategies for choosing partners and getting your efforts off the ground, and discusses how building relationships with key stakeholders over time can position your coalition to influence policies that support the health and well-being of young people.

Women, Aging and HIV

This webinar addresses the impact of HIV and aging on women. It will address recent data on the impact of HIV/AIDS on older women; the barriers often faced to recruit and retain them in care; and solutions for effectively meeting their diverse needs.
