Composite Variable Definitions	LEO reports use composite variables, which are variables that are constructed from two or more response items on a client encounter form. For example, a record is reported as “MSM” if the client is male, and he reports sexual behaviors with male partners in the previous 12 months. This document defines each of the composite variable categories and levels and may be useful for fully understanding reports generated by LEO.
Target Populations Explained	LEO allows for user-defined target populations in intervention set-up to establish service provision goals for clients with specific demographic and risk factors. This document details how LEO categorizes each client into the specified target populations under different circumstances.
