- ◆ Incorporating HIV Prevention into the Nursing Care of Patients with HIV
- ◆ Clinical Manifestations and HIV Disease Management across the Continuum of Care
- ◆ Antiretroviral Therapies and Strategies for Adherence
- ◆ Major Co-Morbidities of HIV Infection
- ◆ HIV, Mental Health & Substance Use

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This program is designed especially for nurses with some knowledge of HIV/AIDS who would like to increase their HIV expertise, and for experienced nurses new to HIV care.

The HIV Nursing Intensive Learning Objectives

Upon completion of this training, nurses should be able to:

1. Describe the process by which HIV attacks the immune system, and how antiretroviral agents attempt to counteract this process.
2. Describe at least three strategies for successful adherence to antiretroviral therapy.
3. Identify and describe at least two strategies for integrating HIV prevention into nursing care of HIV-positive patients.
4. Identify nursing assessments and interventions for managing clinical manifestations of HIV disease across the continuum of care.
5. Identify nursing assessments and interventions for managing co-morbidities commonly associated with HIV disease.
6. Identify effects of mental health conditions and drug use in HIV-positive patients, and nursing implications for a harm reduction approach to patient care.
