Request for Applications (RFA) for Alzheimer's Disease Research Grants

The Chronic Disease Control Branch, Alzheimer's Disease Program is soliciting applications from eligible research scientists to receive funds for Alzheimer's disease research.

Investigators must be eligible to hold Principal Investigator status at an academic institution in the State of California. California public or private nonprofit institutions are eligible to apply. Applicants must be California-based, and all relevant project activities must take place in California. Institutions and principal investigators participating in a Consortium Research Award are also subject to these requirements.

To submit an application, please read and follow the RFA instructions carefully.

- **Letters of Intent are due by 5:00 PM Pacific Standard Time on January 18, 2016.**
- **Complete applications are due by 5:00 PM Pacific Standard Time on February 12, 2016.**

No exceptions will be made to these deadlines.
