


- Provide primary and preventive care for all existing MSI enrollees

Exhibit 5: Annual Enrollment and Percent of Target Enrollment, by County Years 1 and 2.





Patient-Centered Medical Home Network

- Growth in Network
 - June, 2007: started with 12 community clinics
 - September 2008: ~150 Private PCPs, 14 clinics
 - Today: ~229 Private PCPs and 16 clinics
- Distribution of Network
 - Sept. 2008: 76% assigned to clinics & 24% to private PCP sector
 - Today: 48% assigned to clinics & 52% private



Medically Underserved Areas/Populations (MUA) & Health Provider Shortage Areas (HPSA) in Orange County












Distribution of Orange County MSI Clients and Locations of MSI Providers








Seasonal Flu Vaccines Improved









Outcomes

- For 2007-08 compared to 2006-07 (pre-CI) – changes in rates per thousand enrollees:
 - 34.0% decrease in E.D. visits
 - 36.9% decrease in inpatient days
 - 21.5% increase in Patient-Centered Medical Home visits
- Study of nearly 1,000 patients using *MSI Connect*
 - 52% reduction of future E.D. visits
 - 13% increased likelihood of Medical Home visits
 - Estimated Cost savings \$199.03 per patient
- Co-pay Savings
 - \$4 Pharmacy in Year 3 = **\$1,310,843.78**
 - \$5 Office visit co-pays thru 3rd Qtr = **\$430,565.00**
 - Capitated Agreements in Year 3 = **\$1,253,352.26**





March 23rd, 2010 – Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA)

- Key impacts on MSI Program:
 - Medicaid Expansion – January 1, 2014
 - Adults up to 133% of Federal Poverty level (FPL)
 - Could be as early as April 1, 2010
 - 80% of MSI enrollees will go into Medi-Cal
 - Insurance Exchange With Federal Subsidy – January 1, 2014
 - Up to 400% FPL w/o employer-based insurance
 - Most of the remaining 20% of MSI enrollees will go into insurance exchange

Other Factors Impacting Orange County

- Effective June 22, 2010 (90 days post enactment)
 - \$5 billion for uninsured individuals with pre-existing conditions to obtain insurance coverage in high-risk pools through 2014 (MRMIB)
- Effective Sept 22, 2010 (6 months post enactment)
 - Permanently bans health plans from dropping insurance coverage when an individual gets sick in order to avoid covering the costs of care
 - No more lifetime caps by healthplans
 - Children up to age 26 will be able to remain on parent's insurance
- No coverage for undocumented
 - 222,009 undocumented residents in OC (OCHNA & Urban Institute)

1115 Waiver – State proposal

- Expand CI to all California Counties that wish to participate
- Counties can expand their programs to the extent that county funding is available – means over \$40 million of new federal funding to Orange County
- No increase in county cost – existing funds used for federal match
- In period between now and 2014, CI eligibility, benefits, cost sharing, and immigration status rules will be aligned with PPACA
