SB 792 Implementation

- Starting September 1, 2016, all day care teachers and volunteers must be immunized against
 - Influenza
 - Pertussis
 - Measles
- Implemented by California Department of Social Services
- Visit HOAC's website for a fact sheet

Current Legislative Session

- HOAC tracks 418 public health bills
- 55 priority bills
- 583 health in all policies bills
- 359 health equity bills
- Has positions on 19 bills

VETOED BY THE GOVERNOR

Sponsored Bills

◎ SB 1038 (Allen)

- TB screening instead of testing for community college staff

◎ AB 1554 (Irwin)

- Bans powdered alcohol
- Cosponsor with Alcohol Justice



MOVING THROUGH THE LEGISLATURE

Sponsored Budget Proposals

- Lab Aspire
 - \$1.2 million per year for five years
- TB Elimination Challenge 2040
 - \$10 million per year
- Community Health Improvement and Innovation Fund
 - \$390 million per year for chronic disease prevention



NOT INCLUDED IN THE BUDGET
