The Average Age at Symptom Onset (+/- 5 Years) was 70.31 Years.




The Average Time Lag Between Symptom Onset and the Initial Clinic Visit was 3.86 Years.

1.1% Identified as Gay, Lesbian, or Bisexual.\*




Most Consumers (58%) were Married.

Only 3% Lived in a Health-Related Facility.




The Average Number of Years of Education was 14.63 Years.




Years of Education Ranged From 0 to 26 Years.
