

CASE 1**ATYPICAL HAND, FOOT & MOUTH DISEASE (HFMD) – COXSACKIEVIRUS A6 (CVA6)**

PATIENT: One-year-old male

DETAILS: Presented with vesiculobullous eruption on lower extremities including soles, then upper extremities including palms and mouth and fever of 103.8^o.

OUTCOME: Hospitalized. Confirmed Coxsackievirus A6
