

CASE 2**ATYPICAL HAND, FOOT & MOUTH DISEASE (HFMD) – COXSACKIEVIRUS A6 (CVA6)**

PATIENT: One-year-old female

DETAILS: Previously exposed to HFMD in a playgroup two weeks prior. Presented with rash on palms, soles, buttocks, groin, chin, face, and lips. Multiple vesicles on buttocks and one vesicle on right hand. Other symptoms included a high fever of 102^o and diarrhea.

OUTCOME: Confirmed Coxsackievirus A6
