

CASE 7**ATYPICAL HAND, FOOT & MOUTH DISEASE (HFMD) – COXSACKIEVIRUS A6 (CVA6)**

PATIENT: 15-month-old female

DETAILS: Small bumps on upper arms that evolved into vesicular lesions and eventually erupted. Extensive involvement of hands, arms, feet (including soles), legs, and abdomen. Also presented with fever and sores in mouth.

OUTCOME: Confirmed enterovirus, serotyping pending.
