Monterey County is a socially diverse area located on California's Central Coast. It is a renowned tourist destination with large stretches of coastline and fertile agriculture valleys. The Monterey County Health Department exists to enhance, protect, and improve the health of the people in Monterey County. To accomplish this, the Department provides a wide variety of health-related services in the areas of public health, environmental health, behavioral health, and clinic services.

The Position

This recruitment is being conducted to fill a vacant Supervising Public Health Nurse position in the Tuberculosis Control Unit. Examples of duties include:

- Provide direct supervision and coordination of the Tuberculosis Control team.
- Investigate and manage cases of active tuberculosis.
- Plan, assign, and review the work of staff; assist in hiring staff; conduct performance reviews; issue disciplinary action as appropriate; evaluate staff training needs; and promote team building.
- Provide technical expertise regarding medical, nursing, professional, and/or administrative components of the Unit.
- Coordinate operations with other County departments, community agencies, and medical providers.
- Participate in planning, developing, and reviewing procedures and performance standards.

Compensation and Benefits

Annual salary range for the position is \$6,251 to \$8,533 per month, depending on qualifications. The County offers an excellent benefits package (F Bargaining Unit), including 10 paid holidays, supervisory and educational leave, and deferred compensation 457(b) plan.

Qualifications

Pursuant to Title 17, Section 1305, of the California Code of Regulations, candidates must possess the following:

- A valid California Registered Nurse License
- A valid Public Health Nurse Certificate
- Completion of 7 hours of Board of Registered Nursing approved training in child abuse and neglect.

The ideal candidate will also possess the following:

- Four years of increasingly responsible nursing experience
- Knowledge of methods of tuberculosis case and contact investigations
- Experience with tuberculosis prevention & control
- Knowledge of community health education principles
- Experience supervising a diverse public health team
- Excellent Spanish language skills
