





## Driving Directions to the Sacramento Convention Center:

### **FROM SAN FRANCISCO I-80 (DAVIS, VALLEJO, OAKLAND, SAN JOSE)**

Take I-80 East to Sacramento  
Take Capitol City Freeway turn-off  
Take I-5 Freeway (Redding turn-off)  
Take "J" Street Exit (one-way street, East)  
Take "J" Street to 14th Street  
Convention Center on right hand side

### **FROM RENO I-80 (NORTH HIGHLANDS, ROSEVILLE, AUBURN)**

Take I-80 West (not the Business 80/Capitol City Freeway)  
Take I-5 South to Los Angeles  
Take "J" Street Exit (one-way street, East)  
Take "J" Street to 14th Street  
Convention Center on right hand side  
Or  
Take I-80 West to Sacramento  
Take Capitol City Freeway turn-off  
Take the "E" Street exit  
Take a right on "E" Street  
Take a left on 14th Street  
Convention Center on "J" Street and 14th Street

### **FROM HWY 99 SOUTH (STOCKTON, MODESTO, FRESNO, ELK GROVE)**

Take Hwy 99 to Sacramento  
Take I-80 (San Francisco turn-off)  
Immediately get over to the right lane

Take 16th Street Exit (one-way street, North)  
Take 16th Street to "I" Street (one-way street, West)  
Take a left on "I" Street  
Take a left on 14th Street  
Convention Center on "J" Street and 14th Street

### **FROM SOUTH LAKE TAHOE HWY 50 (FOLSOM, PLACERVILLE)**

Take Hwy 50 to Sacramento  
Take 16th Street Exit (one-way street, North)  
Take 16th Street to "I" Street (one-way street, West)  
Take a left on "I" Street  
Take a left on 14th Street  
Convention Center on "J" Street and 14th Street

### **FROM I-5 NORTH OR SOUTH**

Take "J" Street Exit (one-way street, East)  
Take "J" Street to 14th Street  
Convention Center on right hand side

### **FROM AIRPORT, FOLLOW DIRECTIONS FROM I-5 SOUTH**

### **Airport Transportation:**

#### **Shuttle Service:**

There is no courtesy shuttle available to or from any of the hotels or Sacramento Convention Center. SuperShuttle is the exclusive provider of on-call van service at Sacramento International Airport. The costs from the airport to downtown are approximately:

Shared Van: \$13 for the first person and \$11 for each additional person

Private Van: \$50 for up to seven people.

Reservations are not required (but always a good idea) for the trip from the airport to the hotel unless you need a handicapped accessible van. Pickup areas for passengers are located in the ground transportation area adjacent to baggage claim in Terminal A and at the center island curb in front of Terminal B.

**Taxis:**

You can locate a taxi in the ground transportation area adjacent to the baggage claim area at Terminal A and across from the airport hotel at Terminal B. One-way between the airport and downtown is approximately \$32. Call (916) 457-4862 for reservations/information, and (916) 874-0888 to report customer service problems. While at the airport, dial extension 24360 from a white courtesy phone for more information.

**Bus:**

Public bus transport from the airport to downtown Sacramento is \$2.00. View a schedule at this link:
