SUBJECT: PROGRAM LETTER (PL) 11-08
REMOVAL OF STATE SHARE MATCHING REQUIREMENTS
COMMENCING WITH FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2012

This PL 11-08 advises all *Network* Contractors with a State contract which includes a requirement for State Share that the “State Share matching” fund requirements are to be removed from your existing state contract for FFY 2012 (October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012), retroactive to October 1, 2011 and thereafter. This notification is due to provisions in the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-296), Section 241, enacted on December 13, 2010, which established the Nutrition Education and Obesity Prevention Grant Program in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and eliminated the requirement for State Share matching funds that had been in place for nutrition education since its inception in the early 1990s. Authority for making such contract changes is found in Exhibit C entitled “General Terms and Conditions (GTC) 610” of your existing contract, which is incorporated by reference and located at the Department of General Services’ website, GTC 610, provision 17 reads as follows:

“Unenforceable Provision: In the event that any provision of this Agreement is unenforceable or held to be unenforceable, then the parties agree that all other provisions of this agreement have force and effect and shall not be affected thereby”.


All references or related language regarding State Share throughout your existing contract and in particular Exhibits B and E, Budget Detail and Payment Provisions, paragraph 9, Contractor’s State Share Requirements and Additional Provisions, paragraph A. (1) and (2), are no longer in effect. All other requirements remain in full force and effect.
