


Age-adjusted Death Rates due to All Cardiovascular Disease by California County, 2007

All Cardiovascular Disease includes: rheumatic fever/rheumatic heart disease; hypertensive diseases; ischemic (coronary) heart disease; pulmonary heart disease and diseases of pulmonary circulation; other forms of heart disease; cerebrovascular disease (stroke); atherosclerosis; other diseases of arteries, arterioles, and capillaries; diseases of veins, lymphatics, and lymph nodes not classified elsewhere; other and unspecified disorders of the circulatory system; and congenital cardiovascular defects.
