

## **Annual antibiogram developed using CLSI guidelines with distribution to/education of the medical staff**

An antibiogram is a summary report of antimicrobial susceptibilities of selected pathogens using Clinical Laboratory Standards Institute (CLSI) criteria. It reflects the percentage of a given organism that is susceptible to each of the antimicrobial agents routinely tested. Local antibiograms with pathogen-specific susceptibility data should be updated annually in order to provide guidance to clinicians on choosing empiric therapy.
