Notice of Intent to Award

The Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health (MCAH) Division has concluded its review of funding applications for the Adolescent Family Life Program (AFLP) Request for Applications (RFA) #12-10022. The total amount requested by agencies exceeded the grant award of \$7.2 million.

Awards are contingent upon future federal Title V Maternal Child Block grant funding levels, the RFA appeal process, and contract negotiations. A \$50,000 minimum was allocated to small agencies to support quality services. No other funding increases were given above current agency funding levels. Prior to and during contract negotiations, applicants will be required to submit additional budget and contract information to meet the AFLP RFA requirements. Upon completion of contract negotiations, a contract will be executed and commence on July 1, 2012.

Applicants who wish to appeal the funding decision must submit their appeal in writing as outlined on pages 26 and 27 of the RFA. Only timely and complete appeals that comply with the appeals process as stated in the RFA will be considered.

We are pleased to announce that the applicants listed below have been selected based on the funding criteria outlined in the RFA. Thank you for your interest in the AFLP Program and your continued commitment to promoting the health of pregnant and parenting teens in California.
