### Demographic Summary

Federal Fiscal Year 2014-2015 (10/1/2014—9/30/2015)

**E**arly child home visiting matches parents with trained professionals who provide information and support during pregnancy and throughout the child's first few years. The California Home Visiting Program (CHVP) uses two evidence-based models, Nurse-Family Partnership and Healthy Families America. Services are offered in several languages. These programs target high-risk, low-income pregnant or parenting families. In Federal Fiscal Year 2014-2015, the typical mother served was Latina, 18-21 years old, single, on Medi-Cal, unemployed and with a household income under 50 percent of the Federal Poverty Level.
