

Full line Grocery Store Definition

Pursuant to WIC Bulletin by Regulation (W.B.R.) Section 70200, a full-line grocer is a store stocking the following varieties and quantities of food:

Food Type(s)	Minimum Varieties Required	Minimum Units Required
Cereal	5 or more varieties	5 or more units of each variety
Breads/Tortillas	4 or more varieties	5 or more units of each variety
Fresh Dairy Products	5 or more varieties	5 or more units of each variety
Fruits and Vegetables	7 or more varieties of fresh fruits <u>and</u> 7 or more varieties of fresh vegetables	5 or more units of fruits <u>and</u> 5 or more units of vegetables of each variety
Fresh Meats/Poultry/Fish	4 or more varieties (includes but is not limited to different cuts of the same type of fresh meat.)	5 or more units of each variety
