#	Prior WIC MIS Functionality	WIC MIS Functionality Changed
1.	BO6N Food Package Browse Error (this is an empty package, but in the browse path it displayed food items in it).	BO6N food packages no longer display food items on the "Browse Food Items" screen, but rather display the message "There are no food items in this package" when browsed.
2.	WIC MIS was not converting oz. to quarter lbs. correctly in the Growth Chart when the birthweight was entered on the Health Information screen during enrollment or when entering/changing the birthweight on the Infant Summary screen.	When oz. are included in the birthweight when completing the Health Information screen during the enrollment of an Infant or entering/changing the birthweight on the Infant Summary screen, the conversion to 1/4 lbs. in the Growth Chart will follow the WPPM Appendix 970-80.
3.	In March 2016, WIC implemented the Food Package Final Rule changes which added many additional Food Packages. This caused the WIC MIS Food Package "Pick List" to expand sometimes to 2 or 3 pages, which in turn caused the most commonly issued food packages to be at the end, forcing the local agency user to press F8 to forward to the next screen(s) prior to selecting the appropriate Food Package.	The Food Package "Pick List" now displays the Food Packages in the same order as the Food Package Job Aid.
4.	An incorrect formula Food Item would print when the Tailor function was used with new Food Packages.	The correct Formula Food Item now prints based on the formula type and form choices entered into the WIC MIS regardless if the Tailor function is used.
