The shipping containers and product labels bear the establishment number "EST. 19336" inside the USDA mark of inspection as well as the brand "Coleman Natural." However, these products were sent to establishments and retail stores nationwide for further processing and will likely not bear the establishment number "EST. 19336" on products available for direct consumer purchase. EXPANDED RECALL includes Primal cuts, subprimal cuts and boxed beef produced on June 24, whose shipping containers
