**NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATORY ACTION
REGARDING THE READOPTION OF DPH-10-004E,
SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS: GRADES 7 THROUGH 12**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 11346.1(a)(2), notice is hereby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) proposes to readopt, on an emergency basis, regulations amending Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Sections 6020, 6035, 6051, 6065, 6070, and 6075.

Government Code Section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency regulations to the Office of Administrative Law, the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. A copy of the text of the proposed emergency regulations and a finding of emergency are enclosed. After submission of the proposed emergency regulations to the Office of Administrative Law, the Office of Administrative Law shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency action as set forth in Government Code Section 11349.6.

This is solely a notice of intent to readopt the emergency regulations as previously filed and to continue their current status during the completion of the rulemaking process.
