PR1 Sue Chen Timeline and Begin Project Assignments

Identify all HAI Reports Due To the Public from applicable legislation

SB 739 1288.8 (b)

Public reports on HAI process measures, vaccination rates

Each hospital shall implement and annually report to CDPH on its implementation

of infection surveillance and infection prevention process measures that have been recommended by the CDC Healthcare

Infection Control Practices Advisory Committee (HICPAC), as suitable for a mandatory public reporting program.

Initially these process measures shall include the CDC guideline for central line insertion practices, surgical antimicrobial prophylaxis

and influenza vaccination of patients and healthcare personnel. In consultation with the advisory committee, the

CDPH shall make this information public no later than six months after receiving the data.

1288.8 (d)

Hospitals required to report process measures to NHSN January 1 2008

Each hospital shall submit data on implemented process measures to the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN)

of the CDC, or to any other scientifically valid national HAI reporting

System recommended by the CDC HICPAC. CDC definitions and

surveillance methods shall be used. Hospitals participating in the

California Hospital Assessment and Reporting Task Force (Chart) shall

publicly report those HAI measures as agreed to by all CHART Hospitals.

SB 1058 Due January 1, 2011

Public Report on central line associated bloodstream HAI's

CDPH shall post on its web site the rate of health-care-acquired central line associated blood stream infections acquired at each

hospital, including the number of inpatient days.

Section 1288.55 (b)

Public report on MRSA, c.diff, VRE HAIs

CDPH shall post on its web site the rate of health-care associated MRSA bloodstream infections, health-care associated clostridium difficile infections, and

healthcare-associated Vancomycin-resistant enterococcal bloodstream infections, at each hospital, including information on the number of inpatient days

Section 1288.55 (c)

Requirement for public reporting- use NHSN

(c) Any information reported publicly shall be risk adjusted use NHSN

definition

use CDC formulas for calculating rates. Hospitals shall report using CDC's NHSN

SB 158 Section 1288.8 (e)

Reporting System

In consultation with the HAI-AC, develop a scientifically valid statewide electronic reporting system or utilize and

existing scientifically valid database system capable of receiving electronically transmitted reports from hospitals related to HAI.
