 - Should approved ASP 3-tier definition specifically mention/address antimicrobial stewardship among pediatric patients (in particular, those within a larger adult hospital/setting)?
 - What timetable should be established for the proposed California antimicrobial stewardship collaborative? At what point should CDPH begin collecting information from hospitals about their implementation of ASP components?
 - Once data is collected, should CDPH publicly report this information and how? Should data be reported in an aggregate fashion or by individual hospital? If on an individual hospital level, should the specific components that a hospital achieves or should the category that is met (basic, intermediate, advanced) be reported?
 - Additional ways of promoting antimicrobial stewardship in California: antimicrobial stewardship CME requirement for medical licensure (see materials posted for 10/10/13 meeting)? other ideas?
- 5) Action items (to bring to HAI AC)
 - Recommendation that CDPH disseminate ASP preface/definition as “guidance” to acute care hospitals.
 - Recommendation that CDPH establish a collaborative process among California hospitals to facilitate the implementation of the three tiers of Antimicrobial Stewardship. The collaborative should include representation from a diverse cross section of California hospitals.
 - Recommendation that following the conclusion of the collaborative’s efforts, CDPH collect data on a voluntary basis from hospitals about which of the ASP components they have implemented (timetable to be determined).
 - Tabled Items: the need for additional staff for the Antimicrobial Stewardship Initiative at CDPH
